Veterans Incarcerated Program

The Yakima County Veteran's Incarcerated Program (VIP) works with incarcerated Veterans with various offences in the Yakima County Department of Corrections as well as other municipal jails in the county to successfully reintegrate Veterans back into the community. The program grows out of both a national and local concern for the number of incarcerated and homeless Veterans with non-violent offences within the criminal justice system. The Veteran's Coordinator seeks to engage the Veteran while incarcerated to initiate a positive reentry plan, providing greater opportunity to break the chain of re-offending that often happens. It has been a win-win situation for the Veteran, his family, the legal system and the community.

Program Goals

- Facilitate the successful reintegration of incarcerated Veterans back into our community
- Provide services to address Veterans issues creating a healthier community
- Reduce Recidivism
- Reduce number of homeless Veterans
- Increase number of employed Veterans
