Presenting: Solid Waste Manager Karma Suchan

Commissioner Curtis asked what type of complaints Solid Waste typically receives; Karma responded that they usually relate to windblown litter (which the County has since mitigated with fences), illegal dumping, or odor. Commissioner McKinney noted the roles of Yakima County vs. the Health District or the Department of Ecology: the County is responsible for land use permits, whereas the Health District and Ecology oversee things like air and water quality. Commissioner Linde asked about how long it takes the Health District to

conduct their review; Karma responded that all facilities are inspected over a period of several hours spread across several days, at least quarterly.
