## **Media Release Fatality Traffic Collision**

### Narrative:

On 9/4/21 at about 11:05 PM, Deputies from the Yakima County Sheriff's Office, Yakama Nation Police, Wapato Police and District 5 fire department, responded to a report of a vehicle off of the roadway in the 8400 block of No Track Rd between Wapato and Toppenish. It was reported that there was an individual lying on the ground outside of the vehicle that was not responsive. When Deputies arrived, they found that the female had no pulse and started CPR and used an automatic defibrillator in efforts to revive the female. Medic arrived a short time later and pronounced the female as deceased.

The female was identified as 24-year-old Alexandra Ornelas from the Tieton area. She was the only occupant of the vehicle, a 2005 Chevy Silverado pickup. The next of kin has been notified.

Investigation revealed that she had been travelling northbound, had drifted off of the east side of the roadway for about 300 feet, came back up onto the roadway where the pickup left the west side of the roadway and rolled several times. She was ejected from the vehicle during one of the rolls.

There are indications that intoxicants were involved, along with excessive speed and not wearing a seatbelt.

The investigation is under investigation by the Yakima County Sheriff's Office Traffic Unit.
