How will I get notified of an evacuation?



The Alert Yakima messaging system will be the primary communication method to receive fast and direct emergency alert notifications.

If you are already signed up, make sure your address and contact information is up to date. If you receive a message through Alert Yakima, please confirm you have received it.

How will I know if it is safe to return?

Residents will be notified through **Alert Yakima** when it is safe to return.

How can I prepare for an evacuation?

Prepare a "go bag" containing:



- First aid kit
- Prescription medications
- Non-prescription medications
- Prescription eyeglasses
- Cell phone chargers
- Pet food
- Infant formula, bottles, diapers, and wipes
- Cash and credit cards
- Identifications and passports
- Computer passwords
- Change of clothes for multiple days
- Feminine supplies and personal hygiene items
- Books, games, puzzles or other activities for children

Remember to stay calm, follow instructions, and help one another during an evacuation. Keep this flyer in an easily accessible place and share the information with your family and neighbors.
