



HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES

CARBON MONOXIDE

What is it? An odorless and colorless gas that is made when fuel burns.

Possible symptoms:

- Headache
- Dizziness
- Weakness
- Upset stomach
- Vomiting
- Chest pain
- Confusion

BENZENE

What is it? A colorless or light-yellow liquid chemical at room temperature. It has a sweet odor and is highly flammable. It is formed from both natural processes and human activities.

Possible symptoms:

- Drowsiness
- Dizziness
- Rapid or irregular heartbeat
- Headaches
- Tremors
- Confusion
- Unconsciousness

HYDROGEN SULFIDE

What is it? A colorless, flammable gas with a strong odor of rotten eggs. It can be produced from human, agricultural, and industrial activities.

Possible symptoms

- Dizziness
- Headache
- Weakness
- Irritability
- Insomnia
- Stomach upset
