### SPECIAL TERMS & PERFORMANCE MEASURES

1. **Purpose of the Agreement:** Increase access to behavioral health providers for youth and young adults (YYA) throughout Yakima County.
2. **Program Delivery:**  
Increase behavioral health providers within the following YYA programs:  
Outreach Team  
Emergency Shelters including Extreme Winter Weather  
Resource center  
Young Adult Emergency Home and shelters
3. **Key Activities:** Rod's House agrees to deliver behavioral health services to at least 300 unique youth and young adults annually within Yakima County, by hiring and management of the following positions.
  - Masters-level Licensed Director of Behavioral Health Specialist located at our administration office to oversee all Behavioral Health Specialists.
  - Masters-level Behavioral Health Specialist located at Yakima-based emergency shelters (youth & young adults)
  - Masters-level Behavioral Health Specialist located at Resource Center
  - Behavioral Health Intern on Outreach Team & at Extreme Winter Weather Shelter
  - Behavioral Health Intern at Yakima-based emergency shelters
  - Behavioral Health Intern at Resource Center
  - Behavioral Health Intern Young Adult Emergency Home
