SPECIAL TERMS & PERFORMANCE MEASURES

Whereas, Yakima County, a subdivision of the State of Washington (hereinafter described as the “County” or “Yakima County”), and Yakima Neighborhood Health Services, have entered into a contractual relationship with Agreement 265-2024 to provide homeless services.

Whereas, both parties entered into and executed a contract for existing contract on July 23, 2024 (date of original agreement) and,

Whereas, there is a need to update the terms in the original contract to include Prevailing Wage laws language into the Scope of Work;

Now therefore, the parties agree to the following:

1. Prevailing Wages: The subgrantee ensure all contractors and subcontractors will follow all prevailing wage laws according to RCW 39.12.

 - A. The contractor will submit Intent to Pay Prevailing Wage statements for the contractor and all sub- contractors prior to the first payment being made.
 - B. The contractor will submit Affidavits of Wages Paid statements for the contractor and all sub- contractors at the completion of the project.
2. That all other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain the same and shall be performed by the parties.
3. That the above modifications shall be effective upon full execution of the parties.
